This is the 2nd Annual FACE Relay. It is a team relay based on the firefighter combat challenge relay that we, the MonctonMoves.Com team runs in competition. Monies raised from this event will help the team and the FACE Foundation.

What is different from the real combat challenge is that there is a civilian and a fire department division plus anyone can enter this with friends, family or coworkers.

Teams of 3–5 people run the course that is set-up at MFD's Station 2, performing a job-related task then passing the baton along to the next team member and this continues until the course is complete.

Tasks involve (in order):

Climbing 5 storeys with a 45lb hose pack.

Raising a 42lb roll of hose attached by a rope from the ground to the top of the tower (5 storeys).

Descend the stairs.

Strike a forcible entry simulator (150lb beam) with a mallet approximately 4 ft.

Run through a slalom course of pylons.

Drag a charged hose-line (150lbs) 100 ft and spray out a target.

Drag a dead-weight Rescue Randy (175lbs) 100 ft backwards.

This is a timed event but is for fun and bragging rights. The fastest team in each division will be the winning teams.

Civilian teams can wear sweat or gym clothes and gloves. Fire department teams are asked to wear structural firefighting gear.

The fee is \$20/person, cash or cheque.

We had a great turnout last year and a great time and we hope to do that or better this year.
